

TRIP DATES

July 10 - July 23, 2022

TRIP COST

• \$3,295.00 per person

TRIP REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years or older
- Must submit a \$2,295 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit by MARCH 3rd
- Must complete the Village of Hope application
- Must have a valid passport 6 months beyond the end date of the trip
- Must complete medical waivers and vaccination
- Must attend the monthly team meeting
- Must adhere to proper dress code





THIS TRIP INCLUDES

- Round-trip airfare from Denver to Zambia
- All transportation while on the trip
- All housing while on the trip
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner at the Village of Hope
- Visa to enter Zambia
- Trip flight insurance
- Zambia team t-shirt

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED

- Personal expenses, souvenirs, gifts
- Lunches on days we go to Lusaka
- Your health insurance
- Your required medications, shots, and vaccinations

WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

We plan to work alongside our host at the Village of Hope (VOH). The VOH is dedicated to sharing God's love by rescuing and nurturing orphans and vulnerable children in Zambia.

- We'll be assigned special work projects such as building desks and assisting teachers as needed.
- We'll also spend time quality with the children at the VOH.
- Other assignments will be made based on the makeup of the team.



WHAT TO BRING?

- Bible
- Notebook/pen
- Personal hygiene items (toothbrush, paste, etc.)
- Personal medications
- Flashlight (very important)
- Small knapsack to use on daily trips
- Neck pillow for the long flights
- Hats-wide brim for sun protection
- Sunscreen, sunglasses, lotion
- Laundry detergent
- Snacks (power bars, candy bars or nuts in small Ziploc snack bags.)
- Water bottle
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Towels and twin sheet set for a single bed size

DO I NEED A PASSPORT?

• Yes. Passports MUST be valid for 6 months beyond the end date of the trip. If you don't have one or if you need to renew, please do so immediately.

DO I NEED A VISA?

Yes. You'll need a visa to enter Zambia.

IS IT SAFE IN ZAMBIA?

• Yes. Zambia is a peaceful, friendly country that welcomes all visitors. We'll be staying at the Village of Hope.

WHAT ABOUT THE LUGGAGE?

• You are allowed one carry-on bag and one check-in bag for free. Bags in excess of 50 lbs will incur additional fees at the expense of the traveler.

WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE?

• Our trip will be during the dry season but it will be winter. Layering is advised.

• Ladies your shoulders must be covered, dresses and skirts should be below the knee. Other requirements will be covered during our team meetings.

DO I NEED HEALTH INSURANCE?

• Yes, we highly recommend it. Please contact your current health insurance provider. When asking please verify that your insurance coverage extends beyond U.S. borders.

DO I NEED ANY VACCINATIONS?

• Yes. Details will be covered during our team meetings.

WILL I NEED TO EXCHANGE MONEY?

• Yes. You can exchange money when you are in Zambia.

HOW CAN I COMMUNICATE BACK TO THE U.S.?

• Please check with your phone provider to see what services and rates are available to you. All costs will be your individual responsibility.

DOES THE CHURCH SPONSOR OR HELP PARTICIPANTS PAY FOR THEIR TRIP?

• No but we can provide a sample fundraising letter for personal fundraising.
